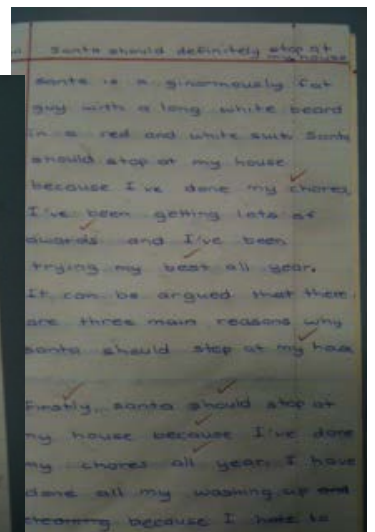
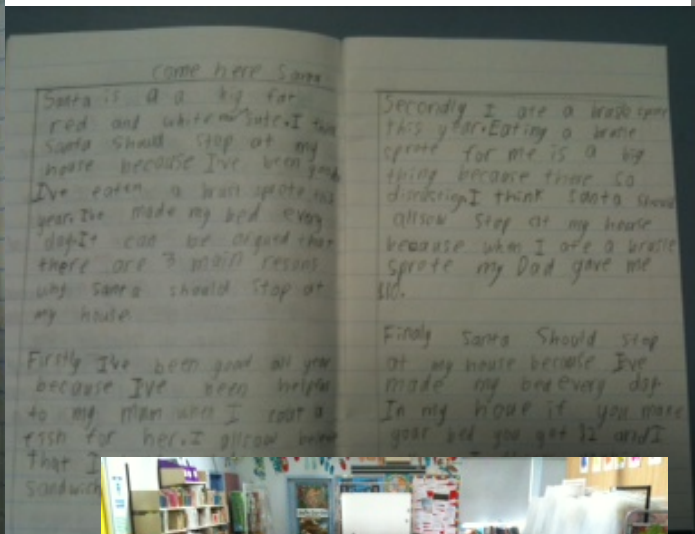
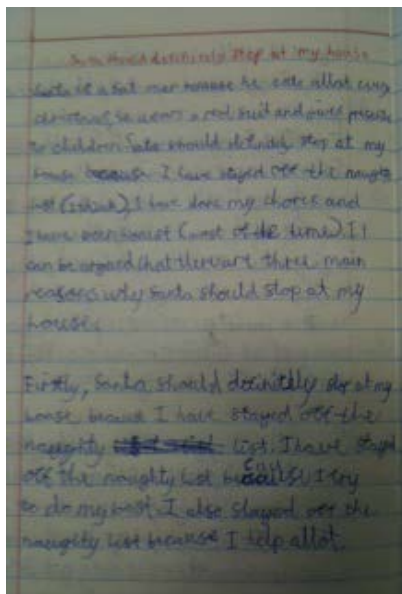
There is sooooo much coming up in the next 2 weeks. Please make sure you have all notes and money handed in on time so you don't miss a thing!

Welcome to week nine! 4/5C have been very busy the past few weeks learning about lots of different topics. In PD/Health we are doing child protection and have been focussing on make safe lifestyle choices.

In Science, we have started a new unit called 'Material World'. We have been learning about solids, liquids and gases and have had some fantastic discussions about how some objects change matter.

In Literacy we have become advertisers! Students are working in groups to plan and create a TV advertisement for a quality text. They have all been working very hard to design posters and props. The finished products will be fantastic!

Math has focused on decoding word problems. We are using Newman's Analayis which has five steps -

Step One - Read the question

Step Two - what is the question asking you to do - circle the question words.

Step Three - How are you going to work out the answer (+, -, x, ÷)

Step Four - Do the math - show your working out and record the answer.

Step Five - Check your math by doing the sum again.

Student's behaviour has been fantastic also! Congratulations to those students who earned their diamond licence last week!!!!
