If you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to come and speak with us. We hope you all have a relaxing and safe holiday.

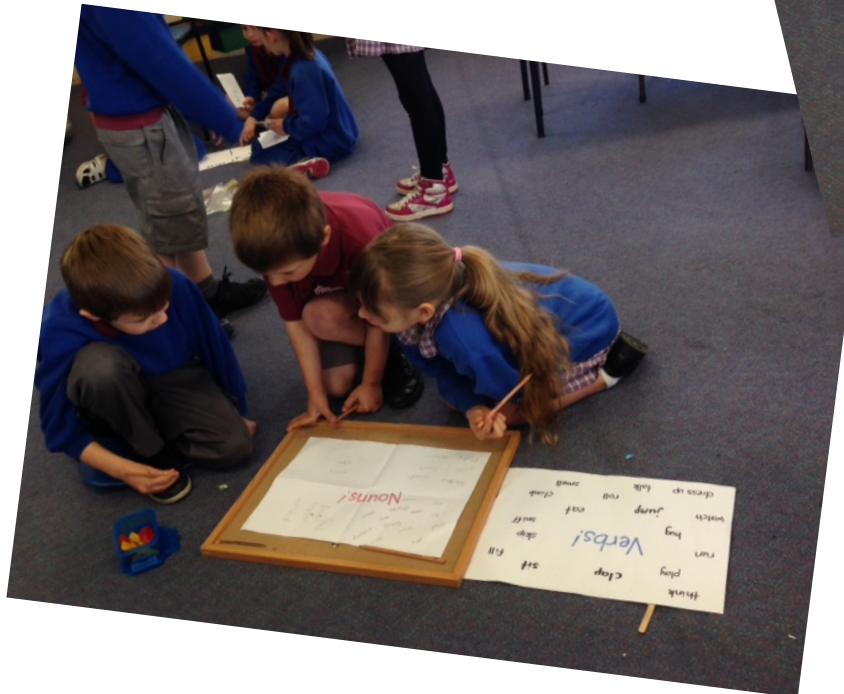

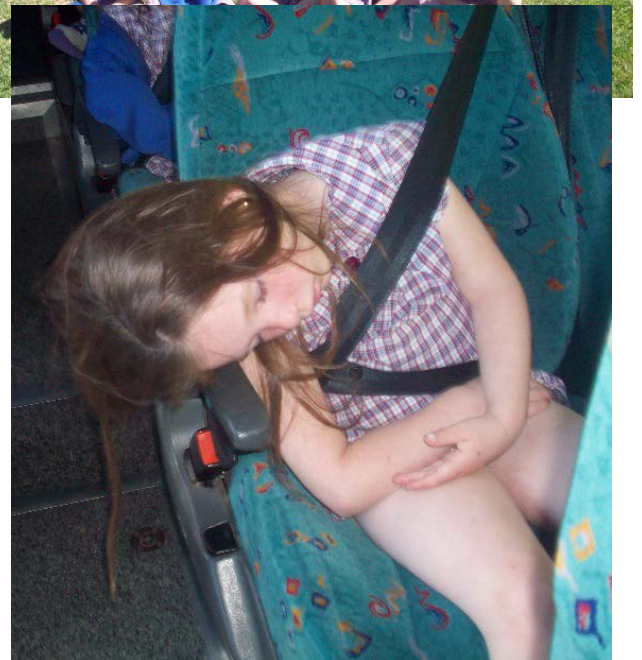
