

I cannot believe it is Week 8 already! We have had an extremely busy fortnight with lots of learning happening!

We are continuing reading the book 'Fantastic Mr. Fox' by Roald Dahl. It is one of our favourite activities when we all sit and read the text together. We might have a few budding actors and actresses amongst us. We have been concentrating on the summarising for our Focus on Reading Super 6 strategy. The students are having fun completing the Sketch to Stretch activities to summarise the main points from some of the chapters we have read.


year, these students will also receive their Principal Award in the coming weeks.

Lunch: 1 medium potato with tuna and cheese, 1 apple Dinner: Macaroni cheese, ½ cup peas, 2 slices garlic
