

As we move ever closer to the end of term, 4/5N have been busy learning new concepts and consolidating others. This

term we have transformed our Mathematics lessons using the EDI technique (Explicit Direct Instruction) and incorporating Google Suite technology. It has been fantastic to see all students engaged in Maths activities. It has been particularly rewarding to witness growth in confidence both individually and as a whole class. Write down a four or five digit number and ask your child to write it in expanded notation!!

In English we have been studying *The Great Bear* by Libby Gleeson. Students have been engaged in quality discussions about author techniques and purpose. Their inferencing and predicting skills have been very impressive.

We have also been dabbling in poetry. Students have been challenged to write Cinquain poems about a character in the studied text *Fox*. The results have been great!


