Early Stage 1


<u>KS</u>





This week's apps are Artkive and Super Why!

FREE – Artkive

This free app has been labelled as the fridge door of apps. It allows parents to take photos of their child's artwork and share it with family members or via social media. It also creates plaques with the picture to allow you to label the picture with your child's name, age and date.



PAID – Super Why! (\$1 for Android, \$4 for iTunes) This

comprehension game enables children to develop their reading and writing skills. Children can create words using alphabet blocks, trace words and find words that rhyme. It also has interactive storybooks that encourage students to find the missing words in sentences.
