On Monday, 22 July we had our School Development Day. Staff focused on a variety of important teacher professional learning opportunities with a key focus on Formative Assessment. Our teaching staff also engaged with the School Plan specifically looking at the Milestone document which outlines the targets for 2019 and beyond and how we are to achieve these. In the afternoon staff also had the opportunity to work in stage teams.

### **Interrelate**

Interrelate will be visiting our school on Thursday, 15 August to deliver some very important sessions on 'Where did I come from?' and 'Preparing for puberty'. These can be very difficult topics for parents to discuss with their child / children. Interrelate have been delivering programs such as these since 1926. These sessions are for families with children in Years 3 to 6. Interrelate charges \$30 per family for one session and \$35 per family for both sessions. As this is a very important program the school is subsidising this program to encourage as many families to engage in this worthwhile experience.
