

From the Principal

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Last Wednesday Mrs Sturgess and I held information sessions over Zoom for the Kinder 2021 parents and carers. We had a fantastic response and enjoyed chatting with parents and answering their questions. Our final Kinder Headstart Transition session will be held this Wednesday between 9.15 – 11am. The Kinder 2021 students are a very happy and settled group and it has been wonderful getting to know them over the past few weeks. This week they will meet their Year 5 buddies who will support them in their transition to school next year.

This week we have some of our teachers continuing to participate in Quality Teaching Rounds Professional Learning where they will be observing each other teach and giving feedback on each other's lessons. There will be some visiting teachers in our school during this time, however the class teachers will leave lessons for continuity of learning and will be at school to check on their classes throughout the day.

Annual Awards Ceremonies

SIGHT WORDS

SIGHT WORDS FOR KINDERGARTEN, YEAR 1 & 2

Your child may have come home with a Sight Word Booklet.

Sight words or high frequency words are words that are frequently used in texts and many are often unable to be sounded out. As such, students need to be able to recall these on sight.



Practicing sights words contributes to improving your child's confidence and progression in their reading and writing.

A number of fun ways to practice them at home is to write the words on cards and play games like Snap, Find Me, Matching.

Students will be tested on Fridays (we suggest keeping your words at home to practice until Friday).

If your child has trouble with a word when tested at school, we will add those words to the new list so they can continue working on them at home.

We have added a comments section on each list for you to write any comments or concerns you have in relation to your child's learning of

Together, we created an incredible artwork that symbolises unity and connectedness.
